WHEREAS the Trans Canada Highway as chosen by the commercial traffic of North America chose from North Bay to Thunder Bay and Highway 17 to Kenora and the Manitoba border as the only fully year-round passable route across Canada;  
WHEREAS the Ontario section of the Trans Canada Highway from North Bay to the Manitoba border, is the only region which remains two lane and dangerous;  
WHEREAS Transport Canada in 1960 found that separated lanes was the main safety factor for highways;  
WHEREAS all other provinces already have a national level Trans Canada Highway;  
WHEREAS divided highways are significantly safer than undivided highways. The benefits of divided highways are emphasized in rural areas, collision rate reductions of up to 60 percent can be expected when converting undivided roads to divided roads;  
  
THEREFORE, the Council of the Township of Harley do hereby, support the study commissioned by *The Working Forest* and sponsored by Manitoulin Transport and Villeneuve Construction to determine the costs and timeline for the creation of a divided highway extending from North Bay to the Manitoba border.
