The Fire Chief addressed Council and relayed is concerned on the current status of our Fire Department. The number of volunteer firemen is decreasing. We need to recruit new volunteer firemen. We have a problem if we get a call during the morning and afternoon. Most people work during the day, if we get a call we just don't get the numbers. Most firemen do not get paid by their employer when assisting on a fire call. He is suggesting that increasing the funds for the point system will give the firemen an extra incentive to join the department. Another concern they have is the inadequate water supply. We need to install water storage tank, so we get easy access to water. The cost of installing tanks is approximately \$15,000. We already have two tanks that was donated to us last fall. We need to install them with a volume pump to withdraw the water from it. The last concern is the pumper truck. It is a 1979 model; it is 31 years old. The pump is functioning perfectly, the body of the truck needs some repairs. Some of the doors do not close properly. The Fire Chief provided Council with a document that indicates the classification assigned to communities with organized fire protection.
