Other material to exclude from the recycling bins

**wood, clothing or tissue, furniture, food, medical products (needles, etc), accessories (shoes, handbags, belts), construction or renovation materials (ceiling tiles, roofing materials, etc), carpets, dead animals or animal excrements, grass and dead leaves**
